


The Strongbeads logo is an old powerful Adinkra symbol, named Adinkrahene.


It is the Chief of the Adinkra symbols and was offered to me. I love it for its simplicity and symmetry.


Beads have a place in almost every area of human life. They help express religious beliefs, political history and social circumstances.

We refer to Bead Culture: they first appeared forty thousand years ago and ever since, they have been made and used by virtually every culture worldwide.


By wearing their own unique beads, their owners express their inner selves.














Beadmaking is a beautiful craft, and their traders are travellers.








Beads are making easily friends

MATERIALS



Pieces made by hand, with love and good energy

I love to work with natural materials especially with shell and with horn.

The animal during its lifetime collects their energy to produce its own protection. With each year that the animal has lived, the shell or horn has grown in depth and strength, and after the animal has passed, it leaves behind this legacy of beauty and protection The dark richness of the horn of the water buffalo is particularly beautiful and hardy, representing the strength and beauty of the beast on which it grew.


This gives it power for me. I source these materials during my travels and on my big walks through the jungles.

The Strongbeads tag is water buffalo horn, cut by a craftsman and inscribed by laser. Another example of ancient life meeting modernity. In this hectic modern life I am selling an old product, used by our ancestors to distinguish themselves from one another.



WE STRING OUR BEADS ON PURE COTTON THREADS THAT WILL STRETCH SLIGHTLY WHILE WEARING. THE WAX COATING WILL DISSOLVE GRADUALLY.













HUMANS HAVE BEEN USING SHELL AND HORNS FOR TOOLS, FOOD, MEDICINE, ADORNMENT AND EVEN CURRENCY FOR THOUSANDS OF YEARS. SHELL IS SOME OF THE EARLIEST MATERIAL USED IN THE FORM OF BEADS. THINK ABOUT THIS: CRUSHED SHELLS ARE A SOURCE OF CALCIUM, PROTEIN AND MAGNESIUM.







BASIC COLLECTION





INDIGO BLUE

A colour that is deep, variable and mysterious. The colour of night skies and deep waters.

A natural plant dye, that began its journey across the globe from India over 6,000 years ago. Indigo is also the sixth chakra colour, which is said to include the third eye. This chakra is believed to be related to intuition and gnosis (spiritual knowledge).

It is said that the colour blue, symbolising the ethos of the worker's life is virtually everywhere, moving from paler through to brighter blues, through to the darkest indigo.

An ancient colour, yet fitting perfectly in modern times, and just like a pair of jeans, can be worn with anything, fitting and flowing with the body's own natural colours ...





CENTIPEDE COLLECTION



The centipede collection, just as the rest of my work, is inspired by nature. The centipede is a fascinating creature, all those legs!

It is reminiscent of a spinal column in the ways it can bend and move.

These beads are threaded in a way in which it can bend and move with the wearer.

All our fasteners are made from naturally sourced shell beads that are from the centre part of a large conch shell. In the Hinduism and Buddhism religions, shankh (a conch shell) is of great importance. It symbolizes purity and auspicious beginnings with its lustre and brilliance.

All of the items are amazingly versatile as they can be interconnected, so several bead lengths can be worn as belts, bodybeads, necklaces, anklets and bracelets, in whatever way fits ones outfit or mood.




GOLD & SILVER

DID YOU KNOW THAT ...

SOME OF THE SMALL GLASS GEMS ARE KNOWN AS 'PONY' BEADS. THE NAME WAS APPROPRIATE, AS THEY WERE PRIMARILY TRANSPORTED INLAND VIA A HORSE (PONY) BACK.

MADE IN EUROPE AND TRADED THROUGHOUT THE NEW WORLD, THESE SMALL ARTIFACTS ARE WELL TRAVELLED AND HAVE PLAYED A POTENT PART IN SHAPING HISTORY.

BEADS HAVE FOUND THEIR WAY INTO MANY SACRED OBJECTS. THE USE OF BEADS AS A WAY TO COUNT PRAYERS IS UNIVERSAL AND IS THOUGHT TO DATE BACK TO THE LATE BC'S.

Beads of any material decorated with circular patterns resembling human or animal eyes are desirable for symbolic and superstitious functions such as averting the evil eye.

In ancient times, it was believed that Spiritual enhancement in the next life could be stimulated through the use of beads, made specifically for that purpose.

SOME OF THE EARLIEST MACHINE MADE (MOLDED-GLASS) BEADS THAT CAME OUT OF BOHEMIA IN THE 1800'S WERE MADE IN THE LIKENESS OF INDIGENOUS FAVORITES. THESE 'SNAKE VERTEBRAE' BEADS WERE WIDELY POPULAR AND COLOURFUL SUBSTITUTES FOR THE REAL THING.

In all of the ancient images, the eye seems to have the widest geographical spread and history.

Eye beads started appearing in

Mesopotamia over 5,000 years ago and have continued to be part of the human adornment mystique ever since.
